Timmy Douglas Stroud, 60, of Huntsville; passed away Saturday, March 9, 2024, at his home. He was born Sunday, December 1, 1963, at Huntsville; to Harold "Butch" Douglas and Patsy Yvonne Fancher Stroud, Jr.

He graduated from Huntsville High School and attended the University of Arkansas. Tim was a farmer and cattleman, and a member of Calvary Baptist Church. 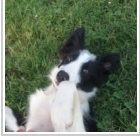
