Tommy Starr Shrum, aged 80, passed away on Saturday, September 16, 2023, at Washington Regional Medical Center in Fayetteville. He was born on Thursday, September 24, 1942, at Pryor, Oklahoma, to Julian Curtis and Roma Jean Holt Shrum.

Tom was united in marriage with Mary Reed on October 4, 1985, and became a family with her son, Travis Reed. That family included his children, Todd and Cindy; and later their grandchildren. Tom was co-owner of Madison County Telephone and Cable Company, which his parents purchased in 1957. He also served in many ways for the Arkansas Telephone Association as a member and where he made many lifelong friends.
