Wallace Williams, 74, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died June 16, 2012 at the Veterans Healthcare System of the Ozarks in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He was born October 30, 1937 at Harts, West Virginia, the son of Erastus and Ruby Scott Williams. He served in the United States Navy and was a member of the Seabees in which he was stationed at Midway Island, Okinawa, the Phillippines and Alaska.
