William Parker Basham, 81, of Huntsville, Arkansas, died November 27, 2009 at his home. He was born October 30, 1928 at Fayetteville, Arkansas, the son of Omar and Pearl Parker Basham. He was the owner and operator of Basham Oil and Tire Company in Huntsville for fifty-three years.
