



## Winfred Ray Hart

July 8, 1922 - January 2, 2017

Winfred Ray "Pete" Hart, 94, of Harrison, Arkansas, died January 2, 2017 at the North Arkansas Regional Medical Center in Harrison, Arkansas. He was born July 8, 1922 at Caddo Gap, Arkansas, the son of John H. and Zula Baldwin Hart. He had retired from the Cooperative Extension Service after thirty years of service.
